SEWER REPAIR

Please provide the following information when applying for a permit:

Apply online using <u>City of Crystal Lake ez APP</u>
<u>OR</u> submit a <u>Building Permit Application</u>
Applications are available at City Hall or online at the City's website, <u>www.crystallake.org</u>.

Inspections:

Please schedule all inspections by 4:00 P.M. the day before the inspection.

The following inspections are needed for a sewer repair:

- Underground (prior to backfilling trench)
- Pre-pour sidewalk, driveway or approach (if applicable)
- Final inspection

Please provide the following when requesting an inspection:

- Inspection type
- Address
- Date and time frame (am or pm)
- Permit number
- Name and telephone number of homeowner or contractor requesting inspection

General Requirements:

- Non-shear couplings with double stainless steel bands are required.
- The sewer material may be SDR26 pipe; however, if the water service is located within ten feet of the sewer Schedule 40 PVC pipe is required.
 - **Note**: In most of the Coventry subdivision area, the water service is within the ten feet of sewer
- Pipe size shall remain the same size as the pipe that was removed.
- Bed sewer pipe with clean gravel on both sides of pipe.
- Cleanout pipe shall be the same size as the pipe to be cleaned.
- A two way cleanout or tee is allowed to be used as the cleanout fitting.
- Remove all foreign material from ditch before backfill such as the pipe that was removed, concrete or debris.
- Backfill with materials that was excavated and maintain the sewer cleanout upright.
- If any sidewalk or driveway is removed the owner / contractor is required to maintain a level surface as the excavated ditch settles until new surface is replaced.

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Permit Requirements:

- Comply with the Illinois State Plumbing Code dated April 24, 2014
- Contact J.U.L.I.E for the location of utilities before excavation
- Maintain street clear for traffic.
 - o No material or gravel to be stored on street or public right of way
- Keep street clean at all times.
- Protect the excavation from the public
- Replacement of public sidewalks shall be completed as follows:
 - o Install grade 9 gravel and compact in 2 foot lifts
 - o Rebar 2 3/8 inches in diameter must be installed into existing sidewalks through new section being replaced
 - o Public sidewalk is required to be replaced within 60 days

Note: If there any changes from the approved plans contact the Community Development Department to review before proceeding.
