

## City of Crystal Lake **Video Gaming Terminal Operator Application**

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation or other entity to engage in the business of video gaming terminal operation, pursuant to the Illinois Video Gaming Act, without first having secured a license from the City of Crystal Lake.

## **Terminal Operator**

The following will need to be completed by the video game terminal operators in order to apply for a terminal operator's license:

| Documentation from the Illinois Gaming Board showing a valid State video gaming terminal operator license.   |

| o Employers' Liability Insurance, with limits of not less than \$1,000,000,00 per occurrence                 |

- Employers' Liability Insurance, with limits of not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence.
- o Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, with limits of not less than \$1,000,000.00 for property damages; \$1,000,000.00 for bodily injury or death of any one person, and \$2,000,000.00 coverage per occurrence.
- o The licensee shall include the City, its officers, employees, and agents as additional named insured on any of the foregoing policies.
