FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – Tuesday August 2, 2016

Crystal Lake – Repainting of a water tower located at 365 Poplar Street will begin in August and is scheduled for completion in November of 2016 (weather dependent). This water tower was last painted approximately 30 years ago.

Crews will be working onsite Monday–Friday 7 a.m.–7 p.m., and may also work Saturdays from 7 a.m.–5 p.m.

Work Process

The project will also include removing and transferring cellular antennas from the water tower to a temporary pole next to the tower. These antennas will be re-installed on the tower after the painting process is completed.

In addition improvements and modifications will be made to steel components of the tank for required updates and to meet current safety regulations for workers.

To contain dust and particles, a large covering, or curtain, will be set up around the tower. Crews will remove current paint before beginning the process of adding new coats of primer and paint to both the inside and outside of this water tower.
