2. **2019-193 – 57 S Oriole Tr** – PUBLIC HEARING

Variations from Article 4-600 to allow the addition to an accessory structure to be over 600 square feet, not meet the principal structure setbacks requiring a variation of 15 feet from the rear yard setback and 4 feet 10 inches from the side yard setback, and to allow the structure to be closer than 5 feet to the principal structure.

3. **2018-139 BLUESTONE (THORNTON) – 911 Tek Dr** – PUBLIC MEETING

A motion is requested to set a public hearing date of February 5, 2020

Preliminary and Final Planned Unit Development for a new 5,500 square-foot gas station convenience store and fueling canopies for truck and passenger vehicles, which requires a Comprehensive Land Use Amendment from Industry to Commerce, Rezoning from M Manufacturing to B-2 PUD General Commercial Planned Unit Development, and Special Use Permit for a Gas Station.

4. **2019-173 HAWTHORNE SELF STORAGE – 100 W Terra Cotta Ave** – PUBLIC HEARING

Rezoning upon annexation to B-2 General Commercial and Office PUD; Special Use Permit for a mini-storage facility; and Variations from Articles 2-300, 3-200, 4-200, 4-400 and 5-200 to comply with the approved site plan.

5. **2019-186 NORTHSIDE CENTER – 40 & 60 W Terra Cotta Ave** – PUBLIC HEARING

Rezoning upon annexation to Office PUD; and Special Use Permit for a resale shop.
