

Crystal Lake

Welcome to the City of Crystal Lake,

As a user of the City's sewer system, you are governed by the City of Crystal Lake Sewer Use Ordinance Number 7586, Section 1, Chapter 435. The ordinance sets forth terms and conditions a sewer user must meet in order to legally discharge into the City's system. Domestic users such as residential dwellings, condos, and apartment buildings are covered under the Ordinance, but do not require a specific discharge permit.

All non-domestic users must complete and return a general Wastewater Discharge Questionnaire (Form A) to the Wastewater Division of the Crystal Lake Public Works Department. Upon review of the questionnaire, the Public Works Analyst - Environmental & Safety Program Coordinator will determine if a Wastewater Discharge Permit is required. Any non-residential use is considered a non-domestic source due to the type of service they provide. Non-domestic users consist of, but are not limited to, industries, commercial and food establishments, retail stores, grocery stores, office buildings, gas stations, car washes, etc. Provisions pertaining to the City of Crystal Lake's pretreatment requirements are incorporated into the Sewer Use Ordinance.

If you are in doubt as to whether you may require a Wastewater Discharge Permit, need to complete a Wastewater Discharge Questionnaire or have any questions regarding the use of City sewers, please contact the Public Works Wastewater Division for assistance.
