BlueCross BlueShield PPO Member Rewards Program

Did you know that providers may charge very different prices for identical procedures?

Reward yourself by value shopping for health care services! You can get quality health care services at cost-effective locations, and you may earn a cash reward by using the BlueCross BlueShield PPO Member Rewards program!

When your doctor recommends a procedure:

Call a Benefits Value Advisor (BVA) to help you shop for and choose a health provider or location for your recommended procedure. They can offer helpful information about medical professionals and locations near you, so you're more likely to save some money! To reach a BVA, call the Customer Service number on the back of your ID card.

OR

1. From your desktop, log into "BlueAccess for Members" .
2. Start a search for your procedure under the "Doctors and Hospitals" tab.
3. Receive service at a chosen location.
4. Program administrator Vitals will verify the location and mail any earned reward to your home.

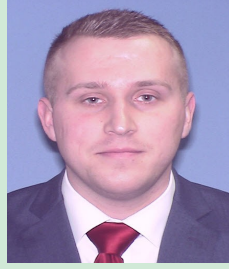

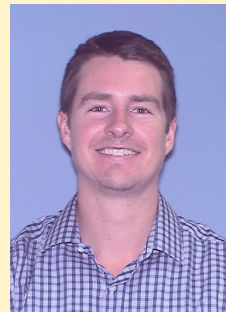
