Jeff was recently promoted to the rank of Sergeant in the Crystal Lake Police Department. He has been with the City and has served the community for just over 21 Years.



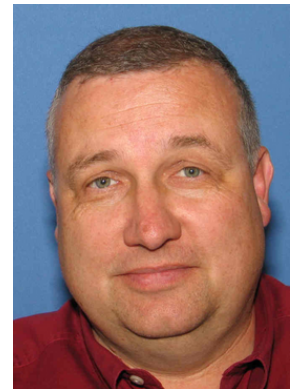

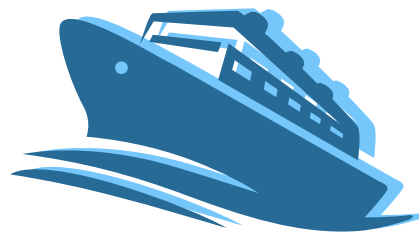
## Employee Retirement
