

## **Background:**

Mr. James Totulis is requesting a wall art project at the Raue Center For The Arts. The wall art would be an all-weather, vinyl 30'x30' print on the north wall of the Raue Center building. The project would include the installation of an aluminum track system adhered to the cement wall. The proposed art work would have both a daytime and nighttime glow best seen during the Spring, Summer and Fall months. Per Mr. Totulis, the benefits are "from ice cream cones to outdoor day and night activity family and friends can enjoy some vibrant geometry of color and dramatic spot light adventure". Mr. Totulis obtained a quote from Fast Signs for approximately \$7,000 for the installation and dismantle disposal.






Please note, internal sign illumination in the Downtown District requires a Special Use Permit.
