

## Internal Measures to Prevent Alcohol Consumption in Teens Partnership

This program is a collaboration between the businesses that sell alcoholic beverages and the City of Crystal Lake Police Department. This program is not designed to eliminate the current compliance check system (stings) where law enforcement uses subjects under the age of 21 to attempt to purchase alcoholic beverages at establishments that hold city liquor licenses. The Internal Measures to Prevent Alcohol Consumption in Teens (IMPACT) program establishes the means by which the employer can work with the Crystal Lake Police Department by creating IMPACT compliance checks for business to reduce the chances of an employee selling alcohol to a person under the age of 21.

This program is voluntarily; it is not a requirement of the issuance of a liquor license by the City of Crystal Lake. Once this application is completed and the fee of \$100 (which covers a one-time IMPACT check) is paid for, the IMPACT compliance check will be conducted at any time within a 60 day period starting from the date of approval. This check will only be performed once, and any further voluntarily checks will come with an additional fee. The IMPACT compliance check will be performed without any prior knowledge and the employer, will be notified only after the IMPACT compliance check has been completed. By voluntarily participating in the IMPACT program, businesses demonstrate their commitment to social responsibility and contribute to the safety and well-being of the community.

The minor will utilize their own legitimate Illinois driver's license for the purpose of providing identification upon request of the employee. In the event the employee asks the underage volunteer their age, the volunteer will provide their actual age to the employee and will not make any attempt to provide a false age, information, or identity.

If the employee provides the alcoholic beverage to the underage volunteer, the officer who is accompanying the volunteer, will speak to the manager immediately after the sale.

This will not relieve the business from responsibility if you are caught in a law enforcement compliance check, and normal penalties will apply.
