ICE ADVICE

Follow these hints to get the most out of ICE:

- Make sure the person whose name and number you provide has agreed to be your ICE partner.
- Make sure your ICE partner has a list of people they should contact on your behalf – including your place of work.
- Make sure your ICE partner's number is one that's accessible; for example, a home number could be useless in an emergency if the ICE partner works fulltime.
- Make sure your ICE partner is aware of any medical conditions that could affect your emergency treatment - for example allergies or current medications.
- If you are under 18, your ICE partner should be a parent or guardian authorized to make decisions on your behalf; for example, if you need a life or death medical procedure.
- Make sure your ICE information is reviewed and updated periodically.
- ICE information will not be accessible to emergency services personnel if you activate your cell phone's security locking system.
- For multiple ICE contacts use ICE1, ICE2, ICE3,... to designate a contact order for emergency personnel.
- Should your preferred contact be deaf, prefix the number with ICETEXT.
