The Crystal Lake Fire Rescue Department Fire Safety House helps increase fire prevention awareness and teaches life safety techniques for both children and adults. This mobile demonstration unit gives residents an opportunity to experience emergency conditions in a controlled environment. The trailer is equipped with a smoke machine to simulate fire conditions that will allow visitors to practice fire escape procedures. Each year, the Crystal Lake Fire Rescue Department uses the Safety House to teach second grade school students about fire escape plans and how to safely exit a house fire. Firefighters talk to the students about having a fire escape plan and practicing it at home.
