Historic Preservation Commission June 7, 2012

1) Call to Order

Chair Alt called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

2) Roll Call/Attendance

3) Public Comment

4) Approval of Minutes of the May 3, 2012 Regular Meeting

5) Certificate of Appropriateness – Lake Avenue Cemetery

The Commission discussed the applicant's request, to transfer the names and dates of the Gates family tombstones and then lay the tombstones flat. After a lengthy discussion, Chair Alt made a motion to approve the certificate of appropriateness, that the Commission send a letter relaying the concerns with facing the tombstones up and their possible further degradation due to exposure to the elements; and the possible idea of laying the tombstones face down, to preserve the remaining inscriptions. Mr. Nemcek seconded the motion. On voice vote, all members voted aye except Mr. Taylor. Motion passed.

6) Trolley Tour discussion

The Commission discussed responsibilities, tour route and some of the highlights of the planned trolley tour.

7) Historic District Update

Ms. Kenney said that the research was almost done. They have discovered many new names and lots of information.

8) Member Inquiries and Reports

Ms. Rozovics mentioned that the McHenry County Historic Preservation Commission is looking to complete a list of approved contractors who do historic renovations. The Commission discussed this and decided that we could continue to refer people to this list and many other available resources we have compiled.
