

MINUTES
Historic Preservation Commission
June 6, 2013

1) Call to Order

T. Nemcek called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

2) Roll Call/Attendance

The following Commission members were present: Tom Nemcek, Austin Taylor, and Bob Wyman. Diana Kenney joined in the meeting via the telephone. Michelle Rozovics arrived at 7:37 p.m. Brice Alt, Lee Ann Atwood, Brenda Sompolski were absent. Staff member Latika Bhide was present.

3) Public Comment

There was no public comment.

4) Approval of Minutes of the May 2, 2013 Regular Meeting

D. Kenney made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 2, 2013 regular meeting. B. Wyman seconded the motion. On voice vote, all members present voted aye. Motion passed.
